Inspiration Behind the New Village Sign

One of our most recent and exciting projects, made possible by LRA fundraising events, has been the commissioning of a new village sign to commemorate this historic and charming village (we are currently waiting for approval, which we hope will be granted in May).

After the recent renovation of the village sign opposite the school, it is hoped that this sign can be placed not so much as a boundary marker but in the centre of the village more as a symbol of arrival and welcome!

As you will see from the image, a willow tree and ducks were chosen for the new sign. The word Laleham in Anglo Saxon means "Great bend or village where withies grow"; withies being willow trees. It is also thought that Laleham could come from "lael" meaning twig and "ham" meaning water meadow or village.

Together with its Anglo Saxon meaning and its long association with the Thames and its water meadows, it was thought that the graceful willow tree perfectly represented the village.

Whilst we have many families of swans at Laleham, this is the emblem of Staines, so the humble but characterful duck was chosen which is a much loved resident of Laleham and during the summer can be fed by hand on the river bank by Laleham Park.

Such a wonderful sign can't be erected without due pomp and ceremony and plans are afoot to how best achieve this involving as many of the village residents and businesses as possible. So if you have any ideas, please contact us!
